一、活动资料

二、 本比赛公开予新加坡全国学生参加，并设有学前组、儿童组 A、儿童组 B 及青少年组。

- 学前组: 4-6 岁
- 儿童组 A: 小学 1-3 年级
- 儿童组 B: 小学 4-6 年级
- 青少年组: 13-18 岁

三、 比赛主题将于活动当天登记时正式公布。

四、 参赛者须于 2026 年 6 月 5 日前完成线上报名。活动当天 (2026 年 6 月 14 日) 亦开放现场报名，时间为下午 2 时至 2 时 30 分。为方便活动安排，主办方鼓励参赛者提前完成线上报名。

五、 参赛者须于 2 小时内完成并提交作品，并可于活动周边指定区域作画。迟到参赛者仍须于下午 4 时 30 分前提交作品，方符合评审资格。逾时者恕不处理。

六、 参赛作品必须由参赛者独立完成。家长、监护人及老师不得从旁指导或代笔。

七、 参赛作品可采用儿童涂鸦 (仅限学前组及儿童组)、蜡笔画、水彩画、素描、油画等形式。参赛者必须使用由主办单位提供的普通 A3 画纸作画，其余绘画工具须由参赛者自备。每位参赛者仅获发一张画纸，如需更换，须以原有画纸进行一对一更换。

八、 参赛者可于比赛当日下午 2 时 30 分 至 4 时 30 分之间提前提交作品；作品一经提交，即视为最终版本，不得修改或更换。

九、 每组设有以下奖项：

- 一等奖 3 份：200 元礼券及奖杯
- 二等奖 3 份：100 元礼券及奖杯
- 三等奖 3 份：50 元礼券及奖杯

十、所有得奖者将于下午 6 时前接获通知，请参赛者于比赛结束后留在活动附近，以便准时出席颁奖典礼。烦请留意主办单位来电，只有得奖者将获通知。

十一、主办单位对任何个人财物遗失或人身受伤概不负责。所有参赛作品将归主办单位所有，恕不退还。主办单位保留修改比赛规则与条规，以及对比赛相关事项作出最终决定之权利。

十二、活动期间将进行摄影、录音及/或录像。参赛者报名及参与本活动，即表示同意主办单位及/或合作单位可将相关照片、声音及影像用于活动宣传、报道、存档、网站、社交媒体及其他相关用途。未满 18 岁的参赛者，须取得家长或监护人的同意。

1. Event Information

2. The contest is open to all students in Singapore and comprises Preschool, Children A, Children B, and Youth categories.

- **Preschool Category:** 4 - 6 years old
- **Children Category A:** Primary 1 - 3
- **Children Category B:** Primary 4 – 6
- **Adolescent Category:** 13 – 18 years old

3. The contest theme will only be revealed during registration on the event day.

4. Participants are required to complete online registration by 5 June 2026. On-site registration will also be available on 14 June 2026 from 2:00pm to 2:30pm. To facilitate event arrangements, participants are strongly encouraged to register online in advance.

5. Participants are required to complete and submit their artworks within 2 hours and may draw within the designated event vicinity. Late registration after 2.30pm is accepted, but participants must submit their artworks by 4:30pm to qualify for judging. Late submissions will not be accepted.

6. All artworks must be independently completed by participants. Parents, guardians, and/or teachers are not permitted to provide guidance or assist in the artwork.

7. Accepted art mediums include doodling (Preschool and Children categories only), crayon drawing, watercolour painting, sketching, and oil painting. Participants must use the standard A3 drawing paper provided by the organiser. All other drawing materials and tools must be prepared by the participant. Each participant will only be issued one piece of drawing paper. Replacement of paper will only be allowed on a one-for-one exchange basis.

8. Early submission between 2.30pm – 4.30pm on the event day is accepted. Once submitted, the artwork will be deemed final and no further amendments or replacements will be allowed.

9. The following prizes will be awarded for each category:

- 1st Prize x3: \$200 voucher and trophy
- 2nd Prize x3: \$100 voucher and trophy
- 3rd Prize x3: \$50 voucher and trophy

10. All winners will be notified by 6:00pm. Participants are advised to remain near the event venue to attend the prize presentation ceremony punctually. Kindly take note of phone calls from the organiser, as only winners will be contacted.

11. The organiser shall not be responsible for any loss of personal belongings or injuries sustained during the contest. All submitted artworks shall become the property of the organiser and will not be returned. The organiser reserves the right to amend the rules and regulations and retains the final decision on all matters relating to the contest.

12. Photography, audio recording and/or videography will be conducted during the event. By registering for and participating in the event, participants consent to the Organiser and/or its partners using the photographs, voice recordings and videos for publicity, reporting, archival, website, social media and other related purposes. For participants below 18 years old, consent from a parent or guardian is required.
